ORDINANCE NO. 07-08 CITY OF MORRIS

At the regular meeting of the Town Council of the City of Morris, the following Ordinance was duly adopted.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, the following Ordinance was adopted:

It shall be a violation for any person private or otherwise to park any item (vehicle, watercraft, boat or ATV) on any public right-of-way for the purpose of sale.

Any person found in violation of this ordinance will receive a fine not to be less than \$100.00 per incident and not more than \$500.00 and/or up to 6 months in the city jail, any item will be towed at the owner's expense.

This Ordinance shall replace any existing Ordinance.
